1820 SETTLERS WILD FLOWER RESERVE (3326 AD)

This reserve is classified as a wild flower garden and as such is not managed as an ecosystem reserve, however a number of vertebrates - notably birds - utilize the artificial habitats. The information for this garden was collected whilst the senior author was resident in Grahamstown.
